However, a study by McKinsey and Company (published in May 2008) has some surprising findings. In that report, low cost is actually one of the last considerations for patients who seek medical care overseas.

The top reasons cited by patients who sought medical care overseas include: 1) advanced technology (40%); 2) better quality of healthcare (32%); and 3) faster medical services (15%). Only 9% of patients in the study cited lower cost as their top reason for seeking medical care abroad.

This means that majority of patients who seek medical care overseas are not simply desperate for lowering the cost of their healthcare. Rather, seeking medical care abroad—known as medical tourism or global healthcare travel—is the result of two things:

- a) The empowerment of patients who now have more options to choose the best medical care they can afford wherever in the world it is available:
- b) The increasing globalization of our way of life, which is already a reality in the areas of trade, commerce, education, science, media, and entertainment.

More and more satisfied patients have sought healthcare overseas, with reported savings in costs ranging from 25% to as high as 90% savings. Usually, these patients sought dental, cosmetic, orthopedic, and cardiovascular procedures.

Medical tourism is a trend that is expected to grow—driven in large part by overburdened local healthcare systems, as well as the lack of medical insurance for most patients. For those seeking high-quality and cost-effective healthcare, medical tourism is certainly a blessing.

Effective cancer management

Cancer affects people of all ages and accounts for about 13% of all human deaths worldwide. Cancer is the uncontrolled growth of abnormal cells because of damaged cellular DNA. These cells invade and destroy adjacent cells and metastasize, spreading to other parts of the body through the blood.

Benign tumors do not invade other cells or metastasize. However, when cells multiply unsteadily, the tumor then becomes malignant, posing danger to normal tissues and deteriorating the body. If not treated early on, the chances of death are high.

Most cancers are treatable

Depending on the overall condition of the patient, the type, location and stage, most cancers are treatable through a combination of procedures. Among the treatments are surgery, where the tumor and nearby tissues are removed; chemotherapy, where a patient is treated with anti-cancer drugs; and stem cell therapy, where stem cells are injected into a patient.

These treatments are available at foremost hospitals like The Medical City. In particular, The Medical City's Regenerative Medicine Program employs advanced technologies in the engineering of stem cells and other biomaterials for the purpose of preserving, restoring, or enhancing organ function.

The Program brings together clinicians from specialized medical fields and scientists from the basic sciences of biology, biochemistry, physics, computer science and mathematics, in developing and delivering interventions to cancer at the molecular level.



New joints for a new you

Degenerative joint disease, otherwise known as osteoarthritis, is a group of abnormalities involving a deterioration of joints. The symptoms of osteoarthritis range from joint pain, tenderness, and stiffness to inflammation, creaking and locking of joints. The causes of osteoarthritis can be genetics, age, weight, previous injuries, illness or infections.

In severe cases, when medications no longer work, joint replacement surgery is an option a patient can consider. In the Philippines, St. Luke's Medical Center has a Center for Joint Replacement Surgery, the only hospital-based training center in the country that caters primarily to joint replacement surgical cases that involve hip, knee, shoulder and ankle joints.

Long-term favorable results

Joint replacement surgery is a procedure where arthritic or worn out parts of a joint are replaced with artificial surfaces to allow it better movement. Commonly, hips and knees are the parts that undergo such treatment.

Hip replacement is a procedure where diseased cartilage and bone of the hip is surgically replaced with artificial materials or a hip implant. Knee replacement, on the other hand, replaces damaged cartilage or surface of the joint with high grade metal and plastic material called prosthesis.

St. Luke's utilizes state-of-the-art technology, like computer or navigational surgery, which result in high success rates and long-term favorable results with almost no complications. Patients suffering from degenerative joint disease will find these treatments are just what their bodies need to function the way they used to be.

Winning the battle against obesity

Obesity is now viewed by the medical community as one of the most serious public health problems of the 21st century.

When a person weighs 20% or more than the recommended maximum weight for their height, they are considered obese. As weight problems reach morbidly obese levels, the health risks rise proportionately.

However, in cases where a patient is severely obese and has not responded to diet, exercise and medication, surgical procedures, such as Laparoscopic Roux-En-Y Gastric Bypass (LGBP), Biliopancreatic Diversion with Duodenal Switch (BPDS), Laparoscopic Adjustable Banding, and others may be recommended by his doctor.

Studies have shown that such procedures have caused significant loss of weight, recovery from diabetes, and improvement of cardiovascular functions.

Plastic surgery has two notable fields. The first is "cosmetic surgery" or "aesthetic surgery," this specialty enhances the appearance of a person through surgical and medical techniques. Cosmetic surgery is a widespread procedure that over 12 million surgeries were performed in the US in 2007.

On the other hand, there is "reconstructive surgery," which is performed to restore function or a previous appearance that had been damaged. Commonly, impairments stemming from burns, facial injuries, congenital abnormalities (e.g. cleft palate), developmental abnormalities and cancer removals are causes for patients to get reconstructive surgery. The more common procedures for reconstructive surgery are tumor removal, laceration repair, scar repair, hand surgery, and breast reduction.

There are a myriad of procedures for the face such as eyelid surgery (blepharoplasty), chin surgery (mentoplasty), nose job (rhinoplasty), ear surgery (otoplasty), hair transplantation, eye bag removal, liposuction of the face, chin and cheek implants, and face lifts (rhytidectomy). For the body, there are tummy tucks (abdominoplasty), breast lifts and augmentations, buttocks augmentations, scar revisions, and liposuction.

In the Philippines, there are several hospitals and clinics that are leaders in this field such as The Medical City and the Belo Medical Group. 



Visa and Immigration

Except for stateless persons and those from countries with which the Philippines has no diplomatic relations, all visitors may enter the country without visas and may stay for 21 days provided they have tickets for onward journey.

If the duration of your medical treatment will last more than 21 days, you may opt to secure a temporary visitor's visa from the Philippine Embassy located in your country. This visa allows stays for periods of 59 days, extendible for a maximum of one year. To extend your stay after 59 days, register with the Bureau of Immigration or with the office of the municipal or city treasurer in areas outside Manila.

Accommodation

A wide selection of deluxe, standard, economy and pension-type accommodations are available in Metro Manila and in key cities and towns throughout the Philippines. In beach destinations, a variety of resorts are also available.

Transportation

The transportation system in Manila and key cities in the Philippines is smooth and efficient, so going to hospitals and other healthcare facilities is easy.

Communications

The Philippines has international and national direct dial phone and facsimile services, mobile phone sites, internet and email facilities, and worldwide express delivery services.

Most national dailies are in English. Foreign publications are sold in major hotels, malls and bookstores in Metro Manila and in key cities. Six national television stations broadcast mainly in Filipino (ABS-CBN 2, GMA 7, RPN 9, ABC 5, IBC 13 and NBN 4, the official government network). Cable TV is available in most hotels in Manila and in many parts of the country.



TRAVEL TIPS

Foreign Exchange & Banking

Most healthcare facilities accept cash, with the Philippine Peso as the unit of currency, divided into 100 centavos. Bills are issued in denominations of 20, 50, 100, 200, 500, and 1000 pesos. Coins come in 5, 10, 25 centavo and 1, 5, 10 peso denominations.

Most foreign currencies can be easily exchanged at banks, hotels and authorized foreign exchange dealers. Remember to transact only with banks and licensed foreign exchange dealers. Always keep receipts of transactions.

Visitors carrying more than US\$ 3,000 are requested to declare the amount at the Central Bank of the Philippines counter at the customs area. Foreign currency taken out upon departure must not exceed the amount brought in. Keep all exchange receipts for record purposes.

International credit cards such as Visa, Diners Club, MasterCard, American Express Card and JCB are accepted in major establishments, though it's best to check with specific hospitals and healthcare facilities if they accept the particular credit card that you are carrying.




